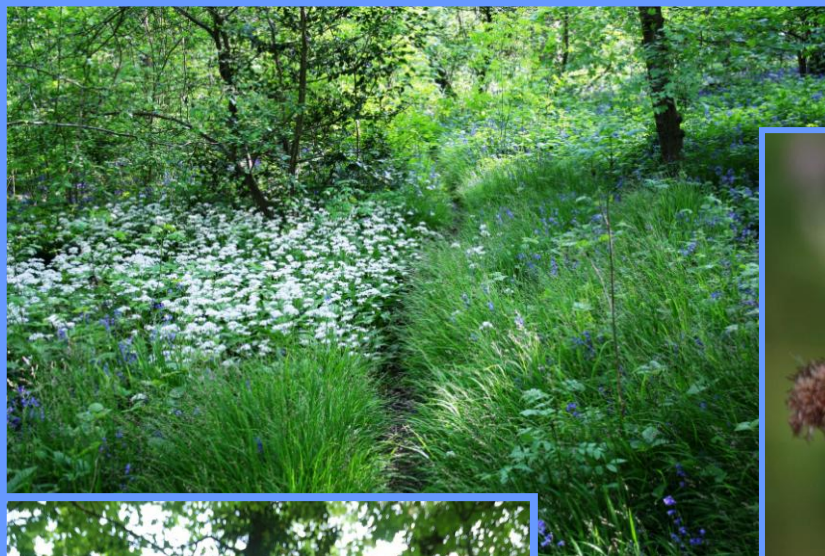


Thank you to all those of you working so hard in so many ways to support this precious local landscape – you are doing something of immense worth.

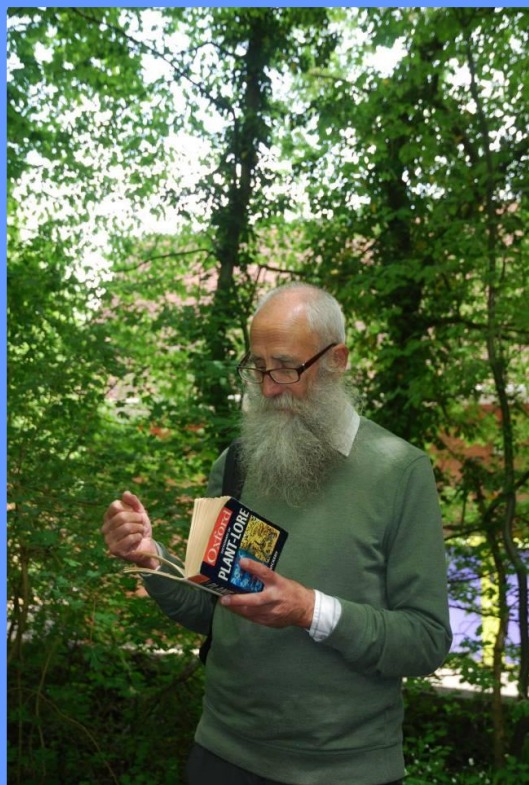
